

New Dengasi Village was established in 1986 by two households: Mr. Ranford M. Marak and the late Jonendra A. Sangma. The village has since grown into a thriving community with a literacy rate of 50%.




## VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

## LAND USE AND LAND COVER ( AREA IN HECTARES)

- **Total Area:** 53.38 hectares
  - Settlement / Built-up Area: 2.52 hectares
  - Roads: 0.25 hectares
  - Water Bodies: 1.92 hectares
  - Agricultural Land: 28.71 hectares
  - Wasteland / Scrubland: 1.86 hectares
  - Open Forest (10-40% canopy cover): 2.76 hectares
  - Moderately Dense Forest (40-70% canopy cover): 15.36 hectares
