Why Beneficiaries Should Share

CROP-Q

VLMAP is a **participatory planning** tool under MegARISE Project.
Based on **FPIC**, Financial Participatory Approach (**FPA**) and **PRA**

Short and crisp template covers geography, socio-economy, resources, gender, SWOT, and action plan

Most of the information can be collected during preliminary visits

Finalized using PRA tools: Transect walks, mapping, FGDs, seasonal calendars, and prioritization (**2days**)

Prioritization of interventions
most important exercise;
community vs individual benefit activities

Optimal ignorance
Don't forget "Optimal ignorance" while collecting information

Annual review
VLMAP revised annually to stay relevant

Why Beneficiaries Should Share

CROP-Q

- 10% of total estimated budget in VLMAP; to be included in the cost estimates/work orders
- Provides VPIC and CMU budget flexibility for interventions at village.

Community Contributions

10% of wage labour cost contributed by communities. Aim for more. If they own it, they will contribute.

Open separate bank account and transfer funds on quarterly basis. After one year, ask for matching contribution from KfW funds.

Funds deposited for O&M of project assets. Can be used from third year onwards.

Promotes accountability, ownership, and sustainability.

Includes voluntary labor, local materials, and funds

Why Beneficiaries Should Share CROP-Q

- Dedicated O&M fund from community contributions and matching grant
- VPIC responsible for monitoring and upkeep
- Covers infrastructure like check dams, plantations, water storage
- A general O&M plan and mechanism for the use of funds should be developed.

What should this be used for

Repair and maintenance of SWC and community infrastructure

Upkeep of community AR and ANR

ESHS, preventive measures
